### Opening: **LANDSCAPE/MAINTENANCE VOLUNTEER**

**Location:** Mother Cabrini Shrine, Golden, CO ([www.den-cabrini-shrine.org](http://www.den-cabrini-shrine.org))

**Start Date:** Every August

**Ministry Term:** 1 Year (renewable)

#### **Position Description:**

Assist the Maintenance/Landscape staff in the overall management of the environment, grounds and buildings at Mother Cabrini Shrine. Become aware of the safety considerations that are necessary in the environment and grounds at the Shrine. Be willing to answer questions and talk to the people who visit while engaged in landscape needs. Share the story of Mother Cabrini and the Shrine.

#### **Requirements:**

Desire and ability to care for the environment. Strong interpersonal, listening and communication skills.

#### **About Mother Cabrini Shrine:**

Mother Cabrini Shrine is located in Golden, Colorado - a beautiful, serene location beyond the foothills of the Rockies. It is a place of prayer, pilgrimage and devotion to Mother Cabrini and the Sacred Heart of Jesus. More than 150,000 tourists, pilgrims, visitors and friends come to the Shrine each year, many of whom climb the 373 steps that lead to a 22-foot statute of the Sacred Heart and a spectacular view of the mountains. The site includes a chapel, and retreat and meeting facilities, and frequently hosts retreats, baptisms, weddings, funerals, vocation walks, and other activities sponsored by the Archdiocese of Denver. Mother Cabrini originally purchased the property as a summer camp for orphan children and for the purpose of spreading the gospel. With her beatification in 1938, the property became the Mother Cabrini Shrine.

#### **Qualifications/Education:**

High school diploma or equivalent. Spanish is helpful, but not necessary.

#### **Experience:**

Experience doing landscaping, maintenance or volunteer work is a plus.

#### **Benefits:**

Healthcare coverage, small living allowance, room and board, transportation to and from ministry site, community living, and assistance with student loan deferment. Spiritual growth and support includes a 2-week orientation plus on-site comprehensive orientation and work-related training, two yearly retreats and a concluding debriefing retreat.

#### **About Cabrini Mission Corps:**

Cabrini Mission Corps is a lay mission program sponsored by the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, commonly known as the Cabrini Sisters. CMC was founded to offer lay people the opportunity to serve for one to two years in the United States or overseas. CMC missionaries make a difference while ministering in education, health care, child care, pastoral ministry, and social services, while living simply in a support community, usually with Cabrini sisters and sometimes with other missionaries.
