Opening: TEACHER AIDE – K-3

Location: Annunciation School, Denver, Colorado

Start Date: Every August

Ministry Term: 1 Year (renewable)

Position Description:

Work with students as a teacher aide in grades K-3 providing individual help in the classroom, tutor one on one with a student, work with small groups and/or correct papers. The teacher directs the activity for each day. Also, use your talents to lead an activity with groups during the after school program as well as to supervise homework and other activities.

Requirements:

Must love young students and be willing to work with teachers to provide the instruction that is needed.

The School:

Annunciation is an inner city, Catholic grade school (grades 1-8) that provides a safe, caring Christian environment for the students.

Other Information:

Many students begin school speaking only Spanish and learn English.

Qualifications/Education:

Undergraduate degree.

Special Skills:

Ability to speak Spanish a plus but not required.

Experience:

New graduate and above.

Benefits:

Healthcare coverage, small living stipend, room and board, community living, spiritual growth and support (2-week orientation, two yearly retreats and concluding debriefing retreat), student loan deferment

Cabrini Mission Corps is a lay mission program sponsored by the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart, commonly known as the Cabrini Sisters. CMC was founded to offer lay people the opportunity to serve for one to two years in the United States or overseas.
