Start Date: Every August

Ministry Term: 1 Year (renewable)

Position Description:

Work in helping to plan and lead Christian activities for grades 9-12 that support living out the Catholic faith and living out the Cabrinian Charism. This includes co-leading 16 class retreats (grades 9-12) with Campus Minister Director, training students in prayer and how to lead prayer groups, planning and leading service outreach programs, helping develop spiritual days of reflection for smaller groups of students, and supporting the Mission Volunteer program through assistance in program development and/or chaperoning on trips. Also, provide a presence to students in the Campus Ministry Center and provide student counseling/advice when needed.

Requirements:

Demonstrates knowledge in Catholic faith and willingness to teach the faith through action and word, desire to grow spiritually, group facilitation skills, ability to multi-task, and willingness to be flexible with work schedule.

Mother Cabrini High School is an independent Catholic college preparatory school for young women sponsored by the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Established in 1899 by Mother Cabrini herself, it has stood at 190th Street in Washington Heights in New York City for more than 105 years. Campus Ministry helps the students of Mother Cabrini High School grow spiritually through activities in clubs, service opportunities, and presence. Campus Ministry moderates 5 clubs, offers two mission trips to Syracuse and New Orleans, offers sacramental prep, assists in planning school liturgies, and provides spiritual counseling. Campus Ministry also has a center where students can come on free periods to relax and experience a peaceful environment.

Undergraduate degree (preferably in Social Science, Psychology, or Theology)

New graduate and above; previous involvement in college Campus Ministry or parish youth ministry a plus

Healthcare coverage, small living stipend, room and board, community living, spiritual growth and support (2-week orientation plus on-site comprehensive orientation and work-related training, two yearly retreats and concluding debriefing retreat), student loan deferment

Cabrini Mission Corps is a lay mission program sponsored by the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, commonly known as the Cabrini Sisters. CMC was founded to offer lay people the opportunity to serve for one to two years in the United States or overseas. CMC missionaries make a difference while ministering in education, health care, child care, pastoral ministry, and social services, while living simply in a support community, usually with Cabrini sisters and sometimes with other missionaries.
